Professionals Guide



Who are we?

Surrey Heath Young Parents Group is part of Surrey Youth Development Service, which works with young people, focusing on 13-19 year olds. The group meets twice a week at the Frimley Green Youth Centre.

What do we do?

We aim to

- Support young parents and parents to be up to the age of 21, with new referrals to the group to be aged 19 and under
- Give young parents and parents to be the opportunity to socialise and make friends with other parents, whilst their children are cared for in an on-site creche
- Encourage young parents to become involved in a range of activities, to challenge themselves and develop personally and as parents
- Provide opportunities for members of the group to gain qualifications and to develop new skills and interests

Who is it for?

The group is for young parents aged 19 and under, although, once a part of the group it is possible to stay until 21 years old.

Where and when?

The group meets twice a week at the Frimley Green Youth Centre.

Wednesday 12-2.30pm

With the support of youth workers and a tutor from Brooklands College, this session is an opportunity for young people to improve their maths and English skills and to gain key skills qualifications. The session can cater for all different levels of ability and offers a fun, unthreatening way of learning.

Friday 10.30am-1pm

A more informal session where young parents can gain support from Youth Workers, and take part in planned activities. In the past, the group has been involved in projects that promote healthy living, outdoor sports activities, the Arts Award and The Duke of Edinburgh Award. We aim to have fun as well as gaining accreditation. Youth Workers are on hand to provide advice and emotional support should it be needed.

A free creche is provided during the session and the young parents transport costs will be met.

Young parents are welcome to come along to one or both sessions.
